
# Young Achievers

Though the perception is that applying sandalwood, **Tilak** is a holy practice, in science it is the cooling properties of sandalwood that have made it the chosen one. Sandalwood calms the forehead and strengthens it. Excessive heat-warms up the forehead and causes trouble within the body. In order to cool it, the practice of applying the sandalwood has been initiated. Applying this Tilak has a scientific meaning attached to it. The region around the nose consists of two wavelengths-one positive and the other negative. One is hot while the other is cool. These waves spread from the nostrils to the forehead area. When the current flows through it, it generates heat. The Sandalwood Tilak is applied at the centre of the forehead to cool this increasing heat. Like Sandalwood we may also apply saffron and haldi (turmeric) on the forehead to cool the system.



This Year Maitree Samooh has honored 1427 Jain Students from twenty Indian states and Union Territories Covering 17 Indian and one International board of education.
